How to get here

By Train: We are approximately a 5 minute walk from Five Ways train station, located on Islington Row.

By Bus: If you are travelling from Birmingham City Centre you can catch the following buses:

From Colmore Row - No. 22, 23 & 29. These buses stop on Calthorpe Road just before St. James Road.



Bus number 8 and 66 also run along Lee Bank Middleway/Islington Row Middleway.


By Car: From the M6:

- -At Junction 6, take the A38 (M) / A38 exit to B'ham (E & C)/B'ham (NE)/Lichfield
- •Merge onto the Aston Expressway A38 (M)
- •Continue onto Corporation St/A38 past Birmingham Children's Hospital then slight right onto Queensway/A38
- •Keep right at the fork and continue onto Bristol Road until you get to Belgrave Middleway crossroads
- •Turn right onto Lee Bank Middleway/A4540
- •George road is the fifth junction on the left, just 80 yards after Five Ways

Wheeley's Road - FREE
